NORTH CANTON, Ohio, May 14, 2015 – Beginning June 11, 2015, the Little Art Gallery of the North Canton Public Library will host “Unveiling the Beauty of Spirit” featuring the work of artist, Deborah Woloschuk. The exhibit will be on display through July 11, 2015.

The Friends of the Little Art Gallery will host an opening reception for the show Thursday, June 11 from 5:30 to 7:30 p.m. Hors d’oeuvres will be served. All are welcome to attend this public reception.

Additionally, each Wednesday, throughout the duration of her exhibit, Woloschuk will use the gallery as a public studio. In doing so, the gallery will serve as a space for live art and education from 3 to 7 p.m. Wednesdays, June 17 and 24 as well as July 1 and 8.

#### Artist Statement:

By faith and prayer, Deborah’s calling by the Master Artist is to appreciate beauty, to know compassion, and to seek truth through creativity. With thanks to the inspiration of the Art Institute of Fort Lauderdale, The Canton Museum of Art, and many more private and artistic outlets, Deborah has won awards and accolades in various juried shows. Deborah has volunteered drawing demonstrations at several schools and art fairs and says “I love to mentor and encourage budding artists of all ages.” While working at the Timken Company (1976-1978), Deborah produced works of art to be used as training slides for Timken’s education and training departments. During that time, her artwork had been chosen two years in a row for the Hall of Fame Football Tossing Coin. She was certified as a florist at Donzell’s Garden Center, and this creative thought and knowledge of floral design often shows up in her artwork. Deborah has completed commissioned works for numerous private collections. Her commissioned works are not limited to portraits of people and include wildlife, pets, automobiles, homes, and boats. Deborah is currently accepting commissions and students of all ages.
