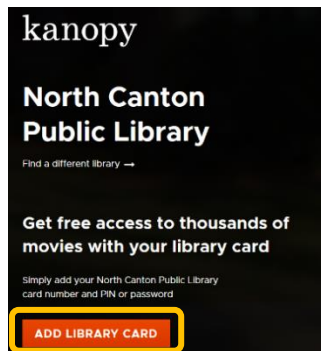
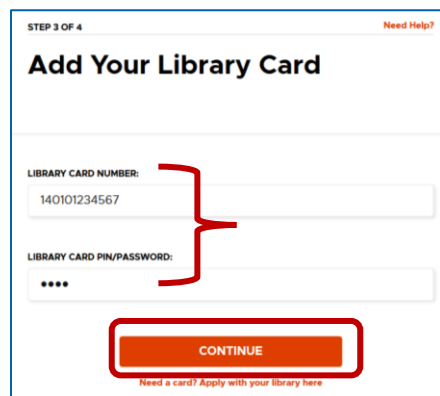


Kanopy is a streaming video service for documentaries, hard-to-find titles, independent films, classic cinema, foreign films, The Great Courses, and so much more. With your library card, stream up to 5 titles a month, watching each film you check out as many times as you wish over 3 days. Because Kanopy titles include a performance license, these films are perfect for presentations and use in the classroom. Alternatively, get the Kanopy app and enjoy the films on Android, Apple devices, Chromecast, Fire TV, or Roku.

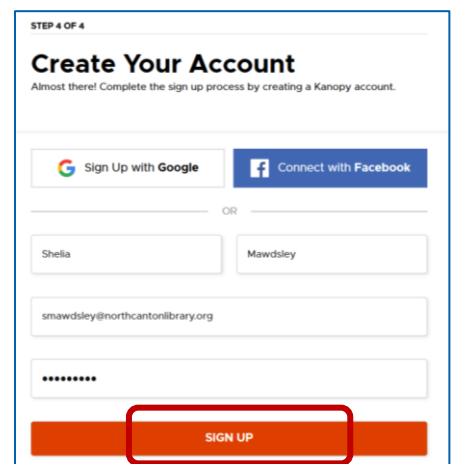


If you reached Kanopy through the Library, select **ADD LIBRARY CARD**. (If you went directly to Kanopy.com, choose **GET STARTED** and then **FIND YOUR LIBRARY** to get to this screen.)

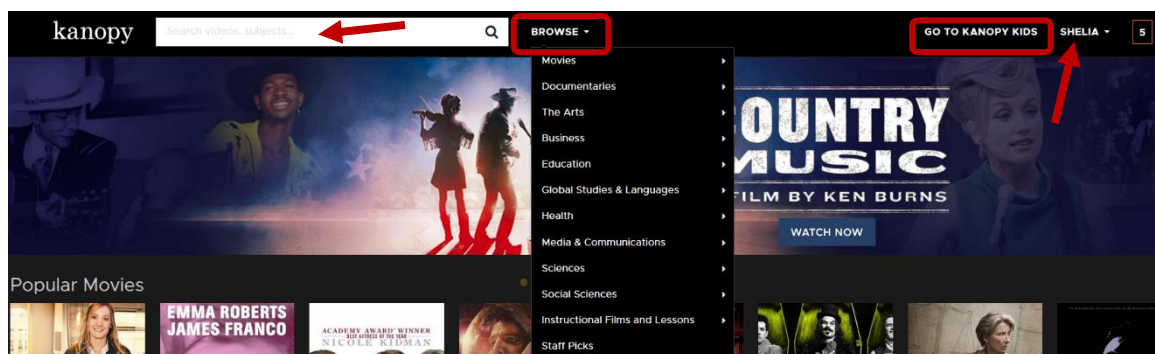


On the next screen, add your **LIBRARY CARD NUMBER** and **PIN** and click **CONTINUE**.

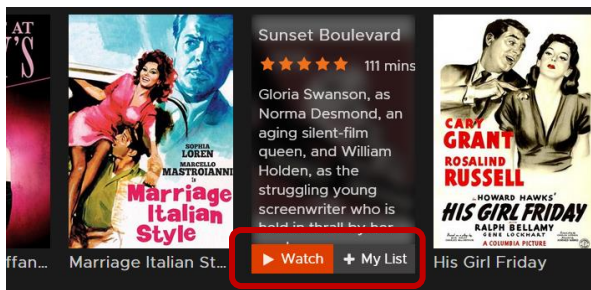
Either log in using Facebook or Google, or set up an account with an active email address. Then click **SIGN UP**. To finish registering with an email, click the link in the email sent to you.



On the home screen, **search** for a movie by title, performer, or keyword in the search box at the top center. Or, **BROWSE** to see what is available in various subject headings. At the top right near your username, there's a **KIDS** option to view only kid-friendly content, which, when available, includes the Common Sense Media Rating. (There is a Parental Controls option on the Dashboard, found under your **username**.)



Also, feel free to scroll down the homepage to see movies listed under various, revolving categories such as Popular Movies, New to Kanopy, Must-See Classic Film, The Criterion Collection, and more.



When you find a film that interests you, hover over it to read the beginning of the synopsis. If you're still interested, you can choose to **Watch**, add it to **My List**, or click anywhere else on the item to be taken to the full record.

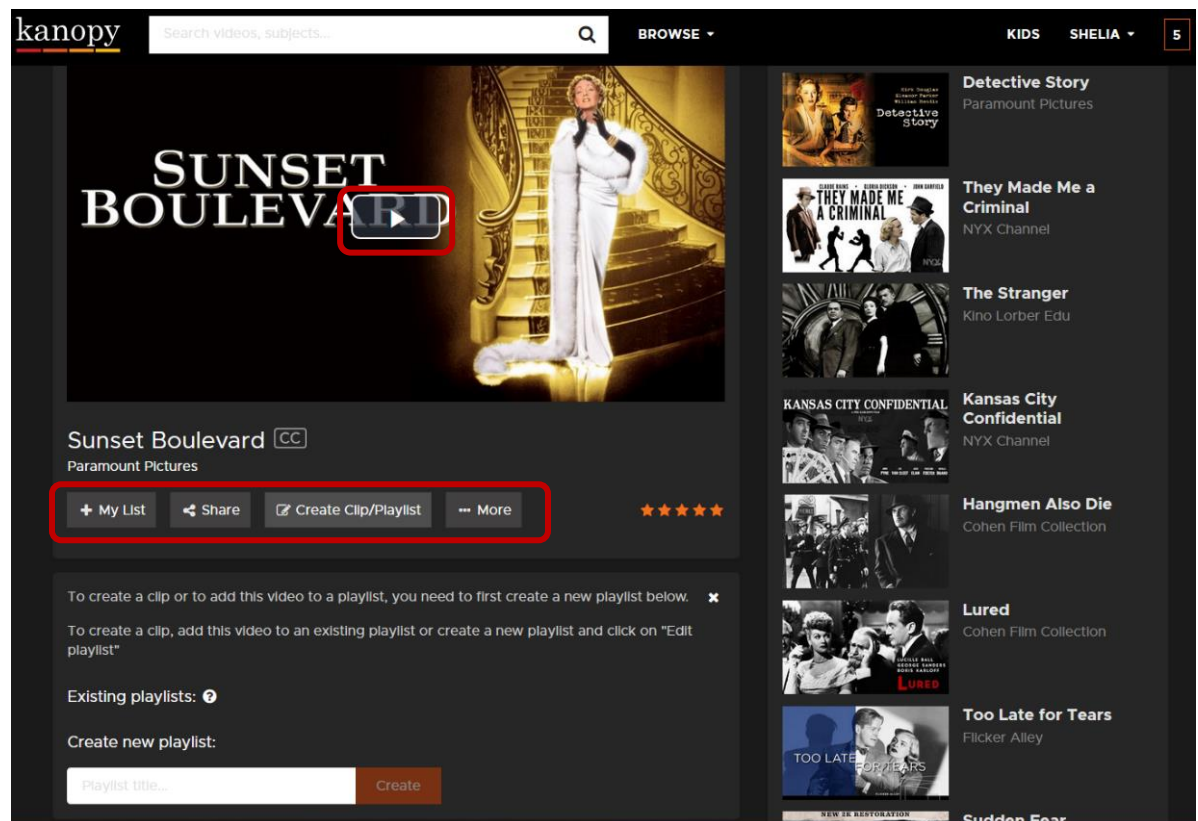
To start watching, simply select the **play button** in the middle of the video.

Under the video are several other features.

Choosing **My List** adds the item to **My Watchlist**, which can be accessed from the menu under your username in the top right, as well as from the Dashboard. You can also

Share a link to the video on social media. **Create Clip/Playlist** adds the video to a playlist you create based on any criteria you choose. Under **More** you can find a complete **Transcript** for the film and a **Citation Tool** to help properly cite the video in a paper.

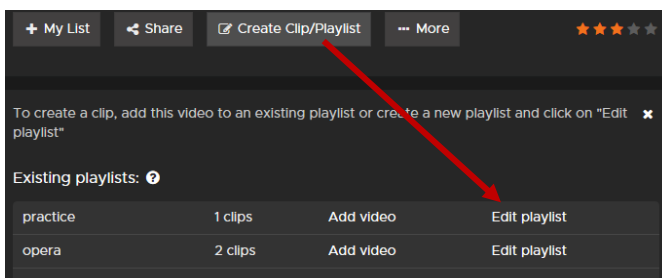
To the right of the video are **Related Videos**, and farther down the screen is a list of the videos watched by others who watched this video and a comments section.



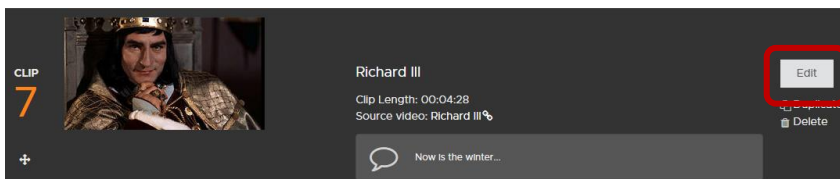


square at the bottom right allows you to play the video on your Full Screen. The corners on the square will invert when in full screen and can be clicked to return to the smaller player on the record page.

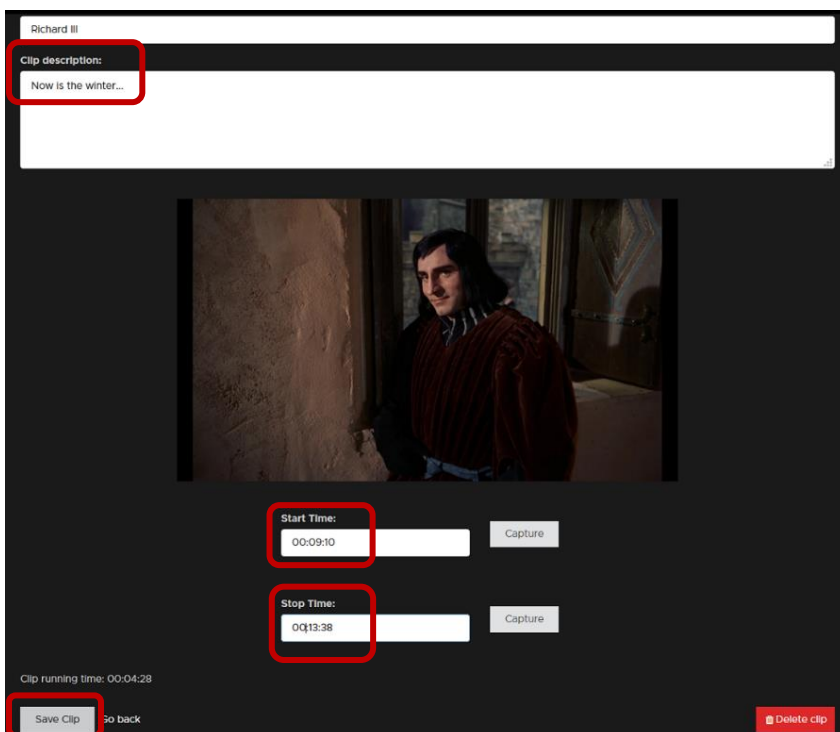
The video player is fairly standard and will look familiar to people who have used other streaming video services. Use the **Play/Pause** icon in the bottom left to start and stop the video. Next along the bottom is the **speaker** icon to adjust volume. Click, hold, and drag the **white dot** to move forward or backward through the video. In the bottom right, click the **1x** icon to change the speed of the video to play it up to two times as fast. Click the **CC** icon to turn Closed Captions on and off. The



If you selected **Create Clip/Playlist** from the video's page, the entire video is now on the Playlist selected. To make a Clip of just part of the video, click **Edit playlist** on the list where you added the video.

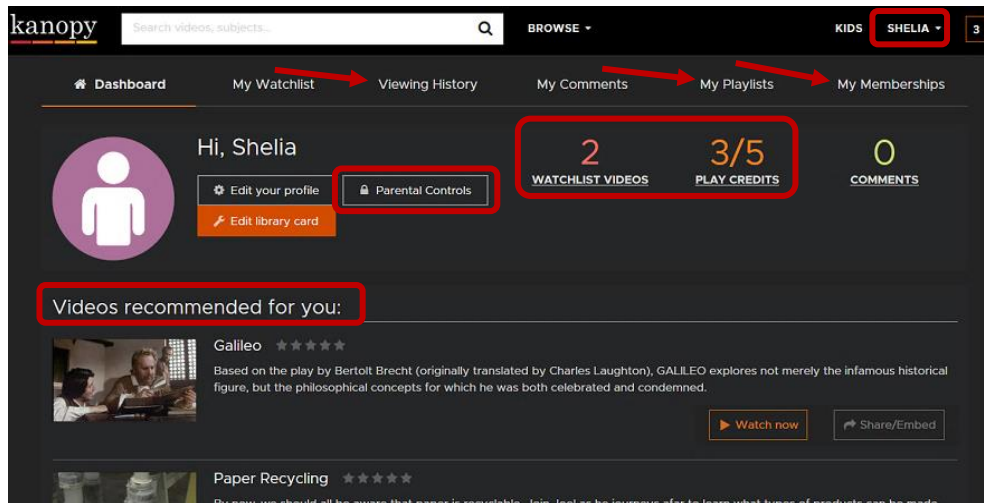


Find the video you want to make a clip of, and select **Edit**.



On the next screen, add a **Clip description** of the clip if desired.

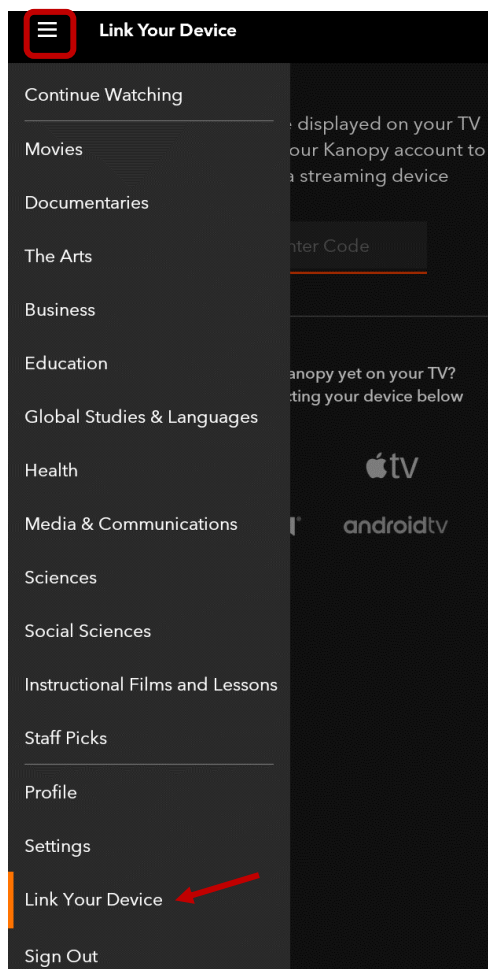
If you do not know the exact timestamps you need, start playing the video just as you would on the video's main page. Once you know when to begin and end the clip, enter the **Start Time** and **Stop Time** under the video. Be sure to click **Save Clip** at the bottom left when you're done.



There's lots of great information on the **Dashboard**, accessible by selecting your name at the top right of the screen. **WATCHLIST VIDEOS** lists videos that have been marked for later viewing by selecting My List. **PLAY CREDITS** shows how many more videos can be checked out in the month. (Currently, I have

3 of my 5 monthly checkouts left.) There is also a **Parental Controls** link. Click this to set a 4-digit PIN. Once KIDS mode is entered, it cannot be left without entering the PIN.

Below are videos Kanopy recommends based on your history and what's popular. Additional options are found along the top of this screen, including **Viewing History**, which lists past and current checkouts, as well as **My Playlists**, groups of videos you have put together. If you belong to multiple libraries that offer Kanopy, manage all of your accounts and library card numbers under **My Memberships**.



Not all options are available on the app. For instance, **Playlists** cannot be viewed, built, or added to on the app for either Android or iOS devices. Browsing by subject heading and the other options that are available can be found under the three line **menu** at the top left of the screen. Additional items include **Link Your Device**, which allows you to wirelessly connect your mobile device to your TV via Android TV, Apple TV, Fire TV, or Roku. A code will appear on the TV to be typed into the **Enter Code** box on the app on your device. Send videos from the Kanopy app to a Chromecast by tapping the cast icon at the top of the screen as with other Chromecast compatible apps.
