Acorn TV is a streaming video service providing television and movies, including many British television favorites. Set up accounts with RBdigital and Acorn TV to get a 7-day pass with unlimited viewing. After 7 days, get a new pass by signing in with the same account information. If you already have an RBdigital account through the North Canton Public Library to use The Great Courses, use that account.


Accounts can be set up on a computer or through the RBdigital app, available free in the Apple App Store, Google Play Store, or other app store where available. However, the Acorn TV app, also free in most app stores, will be required for viewing. Acorn TV is also available on your TV with Android TV, Apple TV, Chromecast, Fire TV and Fire Stick, and Roku. It can also be streamed on a computer.




To access Acorn TV, go to the Digital Video page on the North Canton Public Library website: **ncantonlibrary.com/digital-video**.

Click on the **ACORN TV logo**.

First, sign up for an RBdigital account by clicking **Create New Account** in the top right of the page. (When you return or if you already have an account, select




Login and enter your email and password. It is recommended you access Acorn TV through this page.)




In the popup box, enter your entire NCPL **Card number** with no spaces, then click **Next**.

In the next popup box, enter your **First Name** and **Last Name**. Then enter your **Email** address and **Confirm** it. Then create a **Password** and **Confirm** it as well. Passwords must be at least 7 characters long and include letters and numbers. Click on **Create Account** in the blue box when you're done.






Now that you have an account with RBdigital, the company that provides Acorn TV, you're ready to **Get started** setting up your Acorn TV account.



On this page for Acorn TV, enter your **E-Mail** once more. Create a **Password** and then **Confirm your Password**. Click **ACCESS ACORN TV** and start watching great television! (This password does not need to be the same as your RBdigital account, but using the same may avoid confusion.)




Once you have set up your accounts with RBdigital and Acorn TV, you can log into your account on the Acorn TV app. Open the app and tap **MY ACORN TV** at the bottom right, then tap **Sign In**.

On the next screen, enter YOUR EMAIL and PASSWORD and tap **Sign In**.





You are now on your account home screen for Acorn TV. This screen contains links, including your **RECENTLY WATCHED titles, MY WATCHLIST** of titles you have marked for later, and MY **FAVORITES** for the titles you decide you especially like. At the top right is a **gear** in iOs (left) or three dots in Android (right), which allows you to access your account information and settings. At the bottom is an icon for ACORN **TV** where you can browse offerings or use the magnifying glass to search by title or name.





To watch a video, tap it to go to the record, where you can read a synopsis, **Watch Trailer**, or **Share** on social media

In iOs (left) at the top right, tap the **heart** to add to My Favorites or the **plus sign** to add it to My Watchlist. If using a Chromecast, tap that **icon** in the top right. To start watching, tap the **Play** icon at the top of the video. Tap



the **arrow** at the top left to return to the previous screen.

With most Android devices (right), the functions are the same except that you access Favorites and Watchlist by tapping the **X icon** at the bottom right.




Once the video is playing, tap the center of the screen for options. In the bottom left, use the **left arrow** with the 10 to go back 10 seconds. Tap **Play/Pause** to start/stop the video. Use the **right arrow** with the 10 to advance 10 seconds. Also, use the **dot** on the slider to move through the video.

In iOs (left) the **headphones** at the bottom right open Audio and Subtitles options. The **icon** next to it opens a menu of basic details about the film. The final icon connects the device to a **Chromecast**. The **X** in the top left exits the video.

Android (right) also utilizes the 10 seconds forward and backward arrows and Play/Pause, only they are located in the bottom center of the video. The Closed Caption option is the **CC icon** at the top right next to the **Chromecast** icon. Exit the video by tapping the **back arrow** at the top left.





In the Settings under the gear/dots located on the home screen, turn on or off the option for **WiFi Only Playback**. (This may be a good option to turn on so you don't inadvertently stream videos using cell data.) Also turn on **Closed Captions For All Video** if desired.


Under Account Settings, you can also **Change Password** and **Change Email** and **LOGOUT/Sign Out**. (This only signs you out on the device you are currently using. If you are signed in on another device, you will remain signed in on it.)


Once you have accounts with RBdigital and Acorn TV set up, you can start watching videos by going directly to https://acorn.tv and selecting **LOG**




IN at the top right. However, you need to return to the Library's Digital Video page every 7 days to get a new pass and sign in again. To avoid confusion and possibly ending up on Acorn TV's pay service, it is recommended you always access Acorn TV by going through http://ncantonlibrary.com/digital-video. And please remember, the library will **never** ask for your credit card.



There are several tabs along the top of the screen, including **BROWSE** and **SCHEDULE**. Browse lets you see the offerings by categories, such as Documentary, Most Popular, and Drama. Schedule lists what's new and what will be leaving the service soon. To the left of **STORE** is a **search box** where you can look for videos by title or name. At the far right is **MY ACORN TV** where you can **MANAGE ACCOUNT** and **CHANGE PASSWORD** as well as **LOG OUT**. Scroll the homepage to see featured categories including your Recently Watched once you have begun watching videos.



Tap a video you would like to watch. On the record page, **Add to Watchlist** if you want to save it for later, **View Trailer**, or if it is a multi-episode series, select the episode.



The **Play/Pause** icon is in the lower left of the video. Next to that is the **speaker** icon where the volume can be adjusted. Click, hold, and drag the dot to move through the video. At the bottom right, click the **CC** icon to turn Closed Caption on and off. The last icon at the bottom right is a **broken square**, which you click to make the video Full Screen. To exit full screen, click the **inverted square**.
